RRF's small entrepreneur Sajeda Khatun has been selected as the best woman entrepreneur under the SEP project. It is noted that 64 sub-projects have been implemented by 47 cooperative organizations. RRF's Sajeda Khatun has been selected among the total of 67000 micro-entrepreneurs following various processes. Under the Sustainable Enterprise Program (SEP) of PKSF, the 3-day long Panya Mela 2024 started on February 8, 2024 at the Bangabandhu Conference Center in Dhaka. A total of 77 entrepreneurs displayed their products through 77 stalls. Entrepreneurs from 37 districts participated in this fair through a total of 47 SEP project implementing organizations.
