SUSTAINABLE WATER & SANITATION PROGRAM







Since April 2023, Water.org and the Rural Reconstruction Foundation (RRF) have been collaborating to expand access to sustainable water and sanitation solutions across 30 districts in Bangladesh. Through this partnership, RRF is providing water and sanitation loans to communities, aiming to increase awareness about sustainable practices and ensure more people have access to reliable water and sanitation facilities. This initiative aligns with the broader goal of achieving safe and affordable water supply and sanitation for all, supporting the Sustainable Development Goals. Water.org, active in Bangladesh since 2015, currently works with 21 partners to drive these efforts.
