Activities Under BD Wash

In January 2025, Rural Reconstruction Foundation (RRF) provided 138 members with sanitation loans totaling BDT 6,211,000 for dual-pit toilet construction, along with BDT **414,000 in incentives**. Additionally, 32 members received water loans worth BDT 1.459.000 to install tube wells and safe water systems. Implemented across 16 upazilas in 8 districts through 25 Microfinance branches, project continues to enhance rural the communities' access to safe water and sanitation.

Midwifery Training Provided Under RRF's Community Health Care


