Heifer International has initiated a flower value chain study in Jhikargacha Upazila, starting on February 22, 2025, and concluding on March 1, 2025. A team from Sher-e-Bangla Agricultural University (SAU) is conducting 229 household surveys, FGDs, and KIIs with key stakeholders, including producers, traders, processors, and consumers. On February 24, SAU professors visited Gerbera Nari Somobay Somiti members at Panisara to discuss sector challenges, opportunities, and expectations. The study aims to strengthen the flower industry by identifying key issues and potential improvements in the value chain.
